

## Engaging in and promoting assessment practices

This module concentrates on the RPL process itself and the return on investment of integrated assessment in this process.

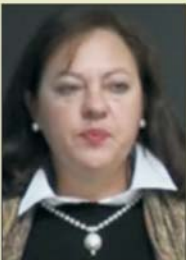
