Enrolment requirements applicable to employed candidates who wish to complete this qualification:

- A minimum of a matric certificate or equivalent NQF 3 literacy and numeracy
- A minimum of three years of general workplace experience

Applicants must have access to a workplace where the learning may be applied so as to produce evidence to be included in a portfolio for assessment of competence.

After all three training modules, an online learner support session is scheduled to assist candidates in reviewing their Portfolios of Evidence in preparation for assessment.
